



# Our Learning Adventure

## Autumn Term 2

In nursery, we talk to the children about 'going on an adventure'. This relates to the learning that they will be doing through their play. This term we will be going on the following adventures:



This half term we will be looking at 'What do we all celebrate?'. We will be looking at events such as Remembrance Day, Diwali, our birthdays and Christmas. You could talk about the things that you celebrate at home and share pictures of this with us on Tapestry.



Our core story this half term is 'The Colour Monster'. We will be thinking about how we feel and the different emotions that we have. You can talk to your child about their emotions and what colour they are.
