## Our Learning Adventure




## Summer Term 1

In nursery, we talk to the children about 'going on an adventure'. This relates to the learning that they will be doing through their play. This term we will be going on the following adventures:



This half term we will be looking at 'Can you use your imagination?' We will be providing children with open resources, such as large cardboard boxes and encourage them to make up their own games and stories. You could

support this by making up your own stories with your child, or read a range of different books and act them out with your child's own toys. You can also make your own settings (where the stories take place) like we do with the children in nursery.



Our core story this half term is 'Peace at Last'. We will be thinking about what happens in the story and the different noises that Father Bear hears. You could watch the story on Youtube if you do not have the book. You could also go on a sound walk with your child and see what you can hear.



In nursery we will be looking at shapes, naming them and identifying them in the environment. You could look at the shapes that you can see in your house or when you are out and about. You could also make a 'shape picture' and share this with us on Tapestry.



We will be taking part in Mental Health Awareness Week from the 13<sup>th</sup> May. This year's theme is 'Movement: Moving more for our mental health'. You can join in by going on a walk with your child, dancing in your living room or going for a swim. Being active
