

Our Learning Adventure

Autumn Term 1

Welcome to our first Learning Adventure newsletter. You will receive one of these each half term, to let you know what we are doing in nursery and how you can support your child by doing these activities with them at home.

In nursery, we talk to the children about 'going on an adventure'. This relates to the learning that they will be doing through their play. This term we will be going on the following adventures:



We have been encouraging all children to put their coats and shoes on independently. Some find this tricky, but we ask them to 'have a go' themselves and show them how to do it. One way that we show them to put their coat on, is by using the 'super-hero' method. An example of this can be seen by clicking on this link

Children who can put on their coat and shoes are then asked to fasten them independently and make sure that their shoes are on the correct feet.





We have been looking at 'What Makes Me Special', talking about ourselves and our families. We have also been looking at things that are special to us. You could talk to your child about their favourite things and post a photograph of this on Tapestry?

Our core story this half term is 'We're Going on a Bear Hunt'. We have been thinking about the story and repeating the phrases. We have gone on a bear hunt outside in the nursery garden as well as going on different adventures, such as going on a lion hunt. You could share the story with your child and come up with your own

adventures, using the pattern of the original story.
