<u>Literacy</u>

Finding familiar characters in books and talking about who they are and what they do.

Looking for signs and symbols in the community and the environment and using these to practice their own writing and mark making.

Mathematics

Showing numbers on our fingers or by matching the right number of objects. Using blocks, rulers and tape measures to measure the size of things. Talking about the shape of things, describing and naming some shapes.

Understanding the World

Different occupations and ways of life and how different people help us in our lives

Identifying things in the local community and talking about where we live and what makes it special.

The importance of re-cycling and not dropping litter to keep our world clean and tidy.

How to help wildlife in the winter months.

How to be safe when we are out and about.

Expressive Arts and Design

Exploring how different instruments sound and how we can change the sounds they make.

Using paint, collage and crayons to create pictures of people, vehicles and the world around us.
