Effective learning

Communication and Language

Physical Development

Balancing, climbing and moving under, over and through objects. Using a range of different tools, to change materials and in role play. How to make sure we get out, use and put away our equipment safely.

Literacy (phonics & early reading/ writing)

Listening to and identifying familiar sounds in the environment. Making different animal sounds

Listening and saying words that rhyme with one another.

Finding familiar characters in books and talking about who they are and what they do.

Looking for signs and symbols in the community and the environment and using these to practice their own writing and mark making.

<u>Mathematics</u>

Compare different aspects such as length, weight and volume using real objects.

Begin to explore different ways to measure things using scales, rulers, measuring tapes and measuring jugs.

Using timers and look at clocks to begin to understand the passing of time.

Understanding the World

Different occupations and ways of life and how different people help us in our lives.

Identifying things in the local community and talking about where we live and what makes it special.

The importance of re-cycling and not dropping litter to keep our world clean and tidy.


How to help wildlife in the winter months.
