#### Effective learning

#### Physical Development

Trying and eating lots of different fresh foods Climbing, jumping and landing properly and safely on the outdoor equipment in nursery.

Using different tools, such as spades, effectively in the garden.

Exploring, describing and naming 2D and 3D shapes

Choosing and using shapes for different purposes and combining them to make new shapes and models.

#### <u>Understanding the World</u>

Talking about the different animals and plants, their life cycles and what they need to grow.

Being careful and kind to all living things and talking about how to look after them and help them to grow.


#### Expressive Arts and Design
