Alongside children's interests and 'in the moment' learning, a part of our focus for learning this term is...

Can you use your imagination?

What are we learning about...

Effective learning

Making links between different things that we've seen, heard and done.

Predicting what might happen next in a story or situation.

Personal, Social & Emotional Development

Being more confidence to speak to friends and grown-ups about what we think, want and the things that we are interested in. Being more confident in different situations for example when we

have activity days, visitors and go out of nursery on trips.

Being aware of the feelings of others and why some things upset people or make them cross, happy or frightened.

Communication and Language

Listening to lots of different stories and rhymes and joining in with key phrases in a story.

Responding to simple instructions and questions and talk about what is happening in a story.

Use our own words to retell stories that we know.

Physical Development

Moving objects in different ways. Pushing, pulling, throwing and catching.

Being safe when we're moving in different ways and around other people.

<u>Literacy</u> (phonics & early reading/ writing)

Making up our own stories, describing where they're set, who is in them, what is happening and why using our Tales Toolkit words and symbols (character, setting, problem and solution)

Finding and saying words that begin with the same letter and identifying the first letter and sound of our name.

Distinguishing between pictures and writing in a book and talking about the different parts of the book.

Mathematics (composition)

Subitising (recognising a small amount or the total of 2 small groups by looking but not counting)

Understanding that different amounts (numbers) can be added together to make a new amount e.g. 4 and 1 make 5 altogether Showing numbers on fingers in different ways.

Understanding the World

Talking about how the garden is changing in the springtime, through to the summer.

Use a range of different computer and audio equipment to get information and complete tasks.

Expressive Arts and Design


Using our imagination and expressing our ideas in different ways Experimenting to mix colours and create different textures and effects for our pictures.
