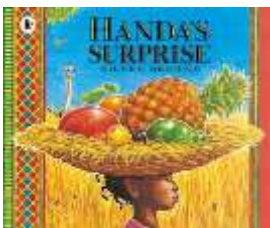

Could we please ask that any nursery clothes that your child has returned home in, if they have got wet or had an accident, are washed and returned to nursery please.



Could we please ask that you return all your child's library books **by Thursday 9th July**. We have a lot of books missing, which makes it difficult to let every child take a book home. Replacing books is also expensive, when we have limited budgets. Please have a good search around your home and return any that you find.



On Wednesday 22nd July, we will be holding our leaving event for children moving up to Reception at The Post Mill. This is just for children who are leaving us at the end of term.

On the day, children will attend the celebration event with their Keyworker Group. **Foxes will need to be there for a 9:30 am start**, with **Badgers starting at 10:30 am**. **Children will need to come in their uniform. Nursery is not open to children on this day.**



At the moment, the weather is very changeable. Could we please ask that on sunny days that you ensure that your child has a hat and sun cream on when they come to nursery (***if your child attends for a whole day please make sure this sun cream is one that lasts all day***). Could we also ask that your child still wears sensible shoes and ***no opened toed sandals***. This is so that it reduces the risk of children dropping things on their toes, or tripping whilst running. We would also suggest that your child brings a coat to nursery, in case the weather changes during the day. As a nursery, all children have access to the outside area regardless of the weather.
